

Purchasing your hybrid Ferrari

Congratulations on the purchase of your hybrid Ferrari and welcome to the family. This sheet will serve as a guide to help you through understanding your Ferrari charging experience.

Know your equipment

One of the most important steps of owning any vehicle is understanding the equipment.

- Charging cable - Level 1 charger - requires dedicated 110v outlet
- Spare Mechanical Keyblade (*pictured to the left*)
 - This is used for **EMERGENCY ENTRY** into vehicle
 - **DO NOT leave this key in the car**



Charging the vehicle

When charging your vehicle, it is important to have a dedicated circuit, not just the outlet. First, turn the vehicle off and open the charge port. Next, plug the charging cable into your outlet. Finally, insert the charger into the charge port. Ensure that one blue light is flashing on the charger, & you are set!

Charging indicators

- One solid blue: No vehicle connected to charger
- One flashing blue: Vehicle is connected to charger
- Both flashing blue: Charging process active
- One orange light: Operating temperature exceeded, may reduce charging
- One red light: Fault during charge cycle



Facts & Tips to Know About Charging

Charging tips

1



• Do:

- Use a Ferrari OEM charger
- Plug in your Ferrari after every drive

• Don't:

- Have multiple electronic devices on the same circuit
- Use an extension cord to plug the charger into the wall

• Did you know?

- The maximum amount of amperage your Ferrari will pull from a circuit is 18 amps
- Most standard US homes have 15 amp circuits
- Ferrari recommends using a dedicated 20 amp circuit for charging your Ferrari

• Storing your Ferrari/Extended Parking

- If you are planning on not driving your Ferrari for a long period of time, you should power cycle the charger every two weeks.
- This is done by unplugging the charger from the car, and the charger from the wall. Wait 30 seconds, and then re-plug the charger to the wall, & the charger to the car

Drive mode tricks

- Driving in Hybrid mode is recommended
- Did you know that if you drive your vehicle the last few miles in qualifying mode, you can help charge your vehicle's battery while still driving? We recommend doing this before charging your vehicle for the maximum results
